



VIKI MARDIS SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

The Puget Sound Chapter of the Infusion Nurses Society (PSINS) is proud to provide the student scholarship named for **Viki Mardis CRNI**, who was tragically murdered July 26, 2002.

The Viki Mardis Scholarship will be awarded annually and two awards are available each year. Undergraduate nursing students are eligible for this scholarship and the winners will receive free attendance at the PSINS Annual Spring Seminar. The scholarship will cover attendance at both days of the PSINS Spring Seminar for each of the two students.

The PSINS Spring Seminar has been an annual event for over 20 years. The seminar focuses on infusion nursing and is informative for nurses practicing in any acute care setting, skilled nursing facilities, home infusion nursing, and other settings. PSINS offers these seminars to provide infusion education opportunities in the Puget Sound area. PSINS attracts nationally known speakers and has a national reputation for presenting excellent infusion education seminars.

Requirements for the scholarship is a commitment to and enthusiasm for the nursing profession and the pursuit of excellence in patient care, attendance at continuing education/professional activities, and interest in the specialty of infusion nursing. These are qualities that Viki embodied.

To apply, write a one-page essay describing why you would like to be considered for the scholarship award. Include in your description how you meet the above criteria. Application deadline is February 28th of each year. The following must be included:
